Application for Admission and General Scholarships

- Both freshman and transfer student application deadlines are August 1, 2006, for the fall 2006 semester. However, to be considered for scholarships, applications must be received by February 1, 2006.
- An online application form and additional information are available at admissions.msstate.edu. In addition, paper applications are available.
- All students must submit a \$25 application fee.**
- Students also must submit a resume at www.sfa.msstate.edu to be considered for scholarships.
- By applying for admission, completing a resumé, and upon acceptance to MSU, you automatically will be considered for most scholarships.
- Have your ACT or SAT scores sent to Mississippi State.
- Have your high school counselor send a six-semester transcript as soon as possible and a completed transcript after you graduate.
- MSU's ACT code is 2220; the SAT code is 1480.

Application for Housing

- Information about campus housing, including an online application form, is available at housing.msstate.edu.
- Submit a housing application with a \$50 non-refundable application fee.
- If you already have a roommate, send both applications in the same envelope.
- Requests for particular buildings are based on space availability.
- Requests for particular roommates are given the highest priority.

Immunization Form

- The form may be downloaded and printed from msstate.edu/web/packet.html.
- Other forms, such as those provided by your family doctor, that provide the same information also will be accepted.
- Students may be admitted to the university but may not register for classes until immunizations are complete.

Federal Student Aid

- The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) should be submitted as soon as possible after January 1, 2006, for students entering in fall 2006.
- MSU Student Financial Aid and Scholarships information is available at sfa.msstate.edu.
- Students may obtain a printed FAFSA in the high school counselor's office or submit online at fafsa.ed.gov by the April 1 priority date.
- MSU's Federal School Code is 002423.

State of Mississippi Student Financial Aid Programs

- MTAG/MESG, Teacher Education, Nursing Education, and other aid programs are available.
- Students should submit applications by the appropriate deadline.

Out-of-State Tuition Scholarships

- Non-resident entering freshmen who are accepted for admission to MSU automatically are considered for a non-resident tuition scholarship based on high school grades and test scores.
- Non-resident community college transfer students are considered for a non-resident tuition scholarship based on community college grades.
