- This *completed* application,
- An official academic *transcript indicating completed credit hours, completed courses and those in which you are currently enrolled, and a cumulative GPA
*Entering freshman applicants may submit a final high school transcript
- Two *letters of recommendation from current academic faculty or administrators
*Entering freshman applicants may request letters of recommendation from high school faculty or administrators
- An essay no greater than two pages in length addressing your interest in a chosen field of study, and
- A personal resume addressing school and community activities and employment history within the last four years.

The S-STEM scholarship, in combination with other educational resources, may not exceed cost of attendance as determined by the Department of Student Financial Aid.

All applicants meeting stated eligibility requirements are considered for S-STEM Fellows regardless of race, color, religion, national origin, sex, age, disability, or veteran status. Applications from underrepresented populations are strongly encouraged.
