Automatically awarded upon MSU admission based on 9th-11th grade high school GPA and test scores. Mississippi State accepts the SAT/ACT through the February test date of a student's senior year of high school.

\*Students with a 34+ ACT/SAT equivalent score will receive a one-year scholarship valued at the cost of their portion of a double occupancy room.

2025-2026 Freshman Academic Scholarships are renewed annually (fall semester and spring semester) up to 8 semesters based on overall MSU GPA. Superscoring accepted.

Scholarship amounts subject to change.

Please note the scholarship amounts listed could be a combination of institutional scholarships/aid and/or private awards.

Students who qualify for and are approved for the Non-Resident Military Tuition Waiver (NRMTW) will receive a scholarship waiver for the non-resident portion of their tuition (currently valued at \$17,435) in place of the Non-Resident Scholarship, if the Non-Resident Scholarship is less than the value of the NRMTW.
